Kirkby is a writer, photographer, traveler and adventurer. JIM PERRIN – UK



Having completed many first ascents and difficult solo climbs, Jim Perrin was one of the U.K.'s leading rock climbers in his youth. He is also a prolific author having penned fourteen books. He has won the Boardman Tasker prize twice as well as awards at the Banff Mountain Book Festival in 2005 and 2006. He has just completed a new book due to be published next spring on the friendship between mountaineers Eric Shipton and Bill Tilman. Perrin is a Fellow of the Welsh Academy and an Honorary Fellow of Bangor University.

Barbara Brownell Grogan's 35-year publishing career began at Time-Life Books as picture researcher and editor and continued at National Geographic, first at the Kids' magazine as editor; then as director of product development, executive editor, and editor-in-chief for National Geographic Books. She has published NYT bestselling authors Stephen Ambrose, Rick Atkinson, and Dan Buettner. She is currently president of Rivanna Publishing Ventures, which establishes partnerships for conservation, humanitarian, and education-focused publications, balancing paper and growing digital products. She holds a BA from the University of Virginia and an MFA from the American University, in Washington, D.C.
