YOUR ENDOWED GIFT WILL BE LEVERAGED FOR EXPANDED IMPACT

When you donate to or create an endowment fund, your gift helps Banff Centre leverage additional endowment funding through the Government of Canada (Canadian Heritage) thanks to the [Endowment Incentives](#) component of the Canada Cultural Investment Fund. Government funds will be applied to our Arts Programming Endowment Fund.

Donations made before October 30th each year will be included in our annual application. In recent years, Banff Centre has received a federal contribution that averages 55 cents for every endowment fund dollar donated.
