Historical Note: This romantic ballet was first produced by **Michel Fokine**, under the title **CHOPINIANA**, for an examination performance in St. Petersburg in the spring of 1908. In March of the following year, it was staged at the Maryinsky Theatre. Diaghilev renamed it **LES SYLPHIDES** when he included it in his first season on June 2, 1909, with the principal parts danced by Nijinsky, Pavlova, Karsavina and Baldina.

The choreography of ADAGIETTO was created to the fourth movement of the Symphony No. 5 of **Gustav Mahler**. The premiere was performed by the Ballet Contemporaneo of the city of Buenos Aires on November 10, 1971 with Ana Maria Stekelman and Maurice Wainrot. ADAGIETTO was given its North American premiere by the Royal Winnipeg Ballet October 2, 1974 in the Manitoba Centennial Concert Hall, Winnipeg, Manitoba.

ADAGIETTO is in form an abstract work, but since the movements and gestures are descriptive of affection, love, and bliss, this is no longer true. The weaving of the bodies, the meeting of emotions, the changing of atmosphere from tenderness to ecstasy describe a story that could only be told through dance.
