Scene: A convent in Italy

## Synopsis:

It is May and we are enjoying a normal day in the life of the convent. When the nuns come out of the church the Sister Zelatrice announces the penances incurred by some of the sisters. Sister Genevieve observes that the sun has turned the water in the fountain to gold and suggests sprinkling some of the golden water on the grave of their lost Sister Bianca Rosa. The conversation turns to the question of desires. Desires are forbidden but Sister Genevieve confesses her desire to be back with the lambs she left in order to become a nun. Surely a pardonable desire. Sister Dolcina is rebuked for her desire for food and drink. When Angelica is questioned, she lies in stating she has no desires.

Angelica has been in the convent for seven years. She was placed in the convent by her aunt, La Zia Principessa, to atone for her sin - an illegitimate child. Angelica has had no visitors in the seven years, until now, when the Principessa arrives to have her sign a document, committing all her wordly possessions to the Principessa, in order that the aunt may ensure a dowry for Angelica's younger sister. The confrontation is bitter. Angelica demands to know what has become of her son. The child is dead. Angelica's love and knowledge of flowers allows her to mix a poison -- The loss of her son is the final agony in Angelica's life.

### GIANNI SCHICCHI

By Giacomo Puccini

Libretto by Giovacchino Forzano English translation by Percy Pitt

Scene: Buoso Donati's villa, Florence, Italy, 14th century

"This hopgoblin is Gianni Schicchi and he goes thus ill-using the others ---- to obtain the mule of Signa falsified in himself Buoso Donati, testing and giving to the last-will a norm."

Dante Alighieri The Divine Comedy

## Synopsis:

The relatives of Buoso Donati are at his bedside. They are mourning his death. His brother-in-law, Betto, passes to the other relatives the rumor that Buoso has left all his money and possesions to the Friars. The will is found—it is true. At the urging of Buoso's cousin's son Rinuccio, (who wants to marry Gianni Schicchi's daughter, Lauretta) Schicchi is allowed entrance into the house, but is rejected by the family as a simple backwood peasant. At the pleading of Schicchi's daughter Lauretta, (who wants to marry Rinuccio) Schicchi agrees to try and help the family and the family, touched by the innocence of Lauretta, allows him to help them.

Gianni comes up with a scheme but warns the relatives that "what we're doing's illegal, the penalty for which is amputation of the right hand and exile forever." So hungry are the relatives for the estate that they ignore the warning. The lawyer arrives and Schicchi uses his great gift of mimicry to impersonate Buoso Donati and dictates a will in the family's favour, but leaves himself the best part of the estate. The lawyer and witnesses leave and the relatives turn on Schicchi in all their fury until he drives them out. His victory is complete and Rinuccio and Lauretta are united --- Greed and love drive men to do many things.
