

DIRECTOR's NOTE

No musical comedy is more packed with characters and surprises than Meredith Willson's **The Music Man**; children, a horse, a charming phoney, a bumbling mayor, a chase, a troupe of classical dance ladies, a train, bunting, a barbershop quartet and a fine romance - all strung together with music so infectious that the most prune-faced sophisticates find themselves sucked in.

The Music Man went through six years and 32 versions on its way to Broadway, where it finally arrived in December 1957 for the first of 1,375 performances. The result of this long development period is a tightly organised story-line, as well as two unusually well thought out leading characters in Harold Hill and Marian Paroo. Willson and his associates were determined that the show should also carry some social weight; Winthrop, who now lisps his way to stardom, started out in early scripts as a spastic child.

As it is, **The Music Man** strikes a note common to many of the world's finest comedies: it is a defense of fun and high spirits, and a passionate put-down of narrowmindedness, pomposity and hypocrisy. 'Dost thou think, because thou art virtuous, there shall be no more cakes and ale?' asks Sir Toby Belch at one point in Shakespeare's **Twelfth Night**. Sir Toby would have got on famously with Harold Hill. We think you will too.
